Decision 03: The PG fellowship/stipend will be paid till the submission of final Thesis/Dissertation or for a period of maximum two years whichever is earlier. In case, the student has not done the satisfactory research work towards his/her completion of Thesis/Dissertation work, he/she may continue without fellowship/stipend till the completion of his/her Degree subject to the satisfactory report by the supervisor and External committee members.
