Additional documents to be produced by the DASA students at the time of physical reporting at NIT Delhi

Following is the list of documents to be produced in original during physical reporting. Candidates must ensure to bring original as well as photocopy of all the documents submitted by them to DASA for taking admission.

- 1. Provisional Admission Letter (issued from DASA 2025), with sign of candidate.
- 2. JEE 2025 score Card issued by NTA (self-attested copy), if applicable.
- **3.** 10th Standard/Matriculation or equivalent certificate or any other certificate issued by government authorities, as proof of date of birth and Name of Candidate).
- **4.** Candidate's passport and Visa (Nationals of Nepal who do not have a passport, copy of Authenticated Citizenship Card needed to be submitted) or/and PIO/OCI card as applicable.
- **5.** Medical Certificate (in specified Format of the DASA 2025 Information brochure as Annexure 10)
- **6.** Mark sheet/grade card and Pass certificate (if issued separately from school) of the qualifying examination.

Or

Certificate from the school studied as proof of completion of 11th and 12th in case of candidates whose final results are awaited (as per the format in Annexure 14 of DASA Information Brochure 2025.

- 7. Mark Sheets of 10th, 11th and 12th (or) equivalent examination(s).
- **8.** Certificate from School authorities (in the format given in Annexure 11 of the DASA 2025 Information Brochure on letter head of the school) as proof of completion of 11th and 12th Standard or equivalent.
- 9. The foreign examination (list mentioned in the Annexure-2 of the DASA 2025 Information Brochure) have been recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as equivalent to +2 stage qualification of an Indian Board giving access to the Bachelor Degree programme at Indian Universities. In case, applicant's qualification is not listed, they need to apply to AIU for an equivalence certificate. (For details Visit Association of Indian Universities website: http://www.aiu.ac.in).

- 10. School Leaving / Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended.
- 11. For candidates who are Indian citizens, certificates proving that he/she completed 11th and 12th class from an institution abroad (as per Annexure 13 of DASA Information Brochure 2025), if it is not clear from the School Leaving / Transfer Certificate.
- 12. Character and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination in current academic year i.e., 2024-2025.

Or

Character and Conduct Certificate from a Gazetted Officer issued on or after 1st March 2025, for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination in years prior to the current academic year.

- **13.** Candidates applied under CIWG category are required to produce all the following documents in addition with the above-mentioned documents:
 - Copy of the passport of the parent working in the gulf.
 - Copy of Parent's visa with a validity on any date in the year 2025.
 - Copy of Parent's Work Permit with a validity on any date in the year 2025.
 - Certificate from the company/organization as proof that parent is working OR
 was working till any date in the year 2025, in gulf country as per format given
 in Annexure 12 of this Information Brochure

Note:

- 1. Admission is provisional and subject to cancel if the student fails to produce the desired documents in original at the time of physical reporting.
- 2. If concerned parents are not able to travel with candidate, attested copy of relevant pages of the parent's passport and visa by a Gazetted officer can be submitted at time of physical reporting along with an authorization letter.
