Examination Pattern and Syllabus for engagement of one post of Junior Translator (Hindi) Purely on Contractual and Temporary Basis advertised vide Advt. No. 18/2025

Pattern of Examination:

For the post of Junior Translator (Hindi) Purely on Contractual and Temporary Basis, an OMR-based written examination of 100 marks will be conducted. The duration of the exam will be 1 hour and 30 minutes, consisting of 100 multiple-choice questions, each carrying one mark. There shall be no negative marking for any incorrectly attempted question.

Syllabus of Examination:

1. The Union's Official Language policy, Constitutional provisions, President's Order - 1960, Official Language Resolution - 1968 (Official Language Act, Rules and Official Language Program). (10 Marks)
2. National Language and Official Language. (10 Marks)
3. Hindi grammar rules, vocabulary, usage and sentence correction etc. (10 Marks)
4. Translation from Hindi to English and from English to Hindi, vocabulary/technical terminology. (10 Marks)
5. Scientific and Technical Translation and Terminology. (10 Marks)
6. IT tools related to Hindi. (10 Marks)
7. History and development of the Devanagari script. (10 Marks)
8. General knowledge related to Hindi. (10 Marks)
9. English language and grammar rules, vocabulary and usage, sentence corrections etc. (10 Marks)
10. English and Hindi passage-based questions. (10 Marks)

Important Instructions:

- Based on the written examination, a total of 6 candidates (in the ratio of 1:6) will be called for document verification.
- The eligibility of candidates for the post will be verified at the time of document verification. Therefore, candidates are advised to ensure that they meet the eligibility criteria before appearing in the written examination.
- The date of written examination is 30th December 2025.
- The admit cards of the candidates will be shared in due course on their registered email addresses.
